**PROJECT OVERVIEW:**

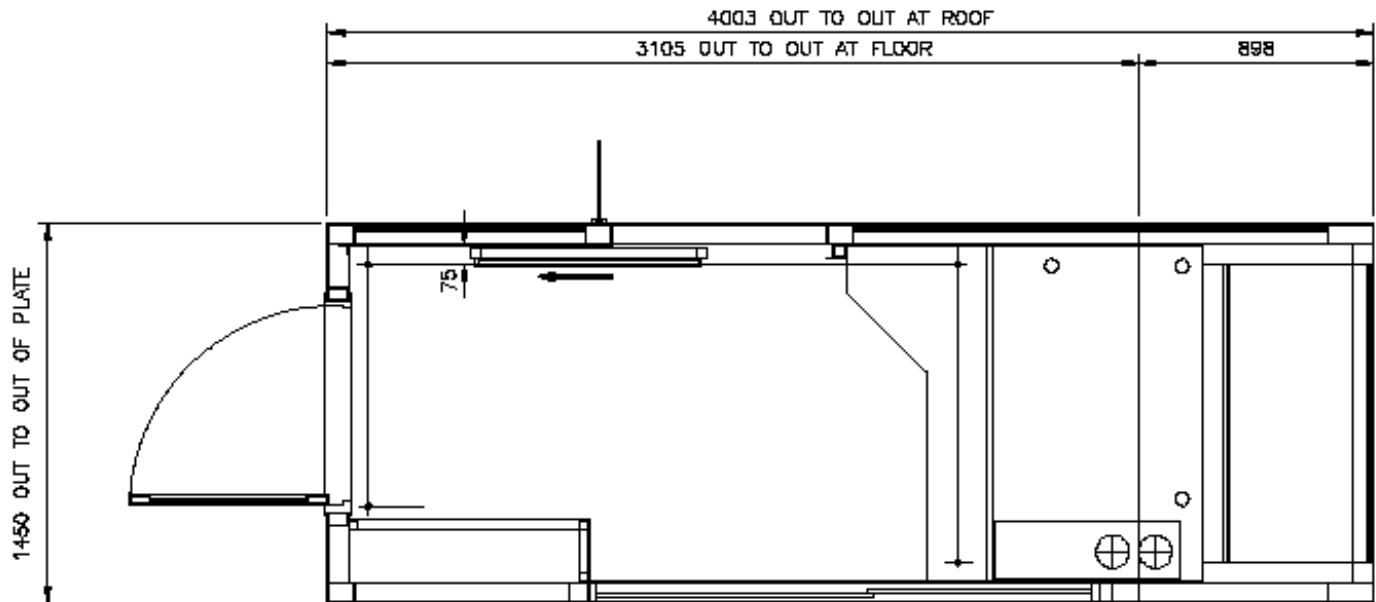
The challenge of an aggressive schedule, budget constraints, ergonomic requirements and a highly innovative architectural design resulted in Canada Kiosk successfully providing sophisticated Toll / PIL Booths for the Fort Erie Bridge Authority. To aid the Canadian Border Services Agency with their final ergonomic review, Canada Kiosk constructed a wood 'mock-up'. Six Toll Booths (Phase I) and 15 PIL Booths (Phase II, pictured above) were fabricated off site at Canada Kiosk's manufacturing facility, the completed booths were installed on site by Canada Kiosk.
